Casula Station and Glenfield Area Weekend Works

Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) will be undertaking construction works in your area over the weekend of 24th to the 25th October 2009.

These works are part of the construction of the Southern Sydney Freight Line (SSFL). In this area, there will be work across the following sites as below:

Casula Train Station - works will begin at 7.00am until 10.00pm on both Saturday and Sunday. The works will be around the lifts that will be installed at Casula Station. The equipment used will be a crane and scaffolding.

Casula Level Crossing - works will begin at 7.00am until 6.00pm on both Saturday and Sunday. The works will involve the construction of an underbore. The equipment used will be an excavator, boring rig, sucker truck, dry spoil removal truck, hiab truck, compaction tools and survey equipment.

North of Glenfield Substation to Glenfield Substation – works will take place from 7.00 am until 5.00pm on both Saturday and Sunday. The works will involve piling, steel works, concreting, demolition and removal of redundant post and traffic hut, ethane gas protection slab, construction of under track and under bore track crossings and the, relocation of cable and cable pit. The equipment used will be excavatos, piling rig, concrete vibrator, franna, concrete agitators and pump truck, general construction delivery trucks and hand tools.

Glenfield – works will take place from 1.00am Saturday until midnight Sunday. The work will involve the transfer of rail legs and the loading of rail onto the rail set for transfer. The equipment used will be a locomotive, rail set and mobile cranes.
