

**Important Community Information**

As notified early, Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) will be undertaking construction works within the rail corridor in your area over the weekend of 7th and 8th February 2009.

These works are part of the construction of the Southern Sydney Freight Line (SSFL). They will involve the following:

**Site One:** Glenfield Flyover – Preparation of construction of bridge foundation – Equipment: Piling Rig, Mini Excavator, Concrete Trucks, Franna Crane, Tray and Tip trucks

**Site Two:** Casula to Glenfield Junction – Vegetation Clearing – Equipment: Excavator, mulching machine 7.00am – 5.00pm Saturday and Sunday

**Site Three:** Surveying – Shepard Street Liverpool to Woodbrook Road Casula, Equipment: Surveying equipment, delivery truck/hiab 7.00am – 5.00pm Saturday and Sunday

**Site Four:** Relocation of high voltage power lines - minor works essentially involving cherry pickers and winches and Pole relocations including digging holes and erecting new poles - Note that this is essentially in the same location as the clearing and grubbing works by Reed.
