Traffic Changes, Broomfield Street, Cabramatta Station

Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) will be undertaking potholing works at Broomfield Street this Saturday 19th September 2009.

The traffic control plan will be implemented at 6.00am until 12.00pm on Saturday, during the pot holing 10 car parking spaces will be closed whilst we carry out the potholing works in this area. These car spots will be taken out to allow traffic to flow around the worksite.

Traffic will be allowed to flow in both directions with stop/go flagmen in place to assist the traffic movements through the worksite.

Pedestrian access at this location will be maintained at all times through out these works.

This closure will be in place for the Saturday only and at midday the traffic will return to its usual arrangement.

These works form part of the construction of the Southern Sydney Freight Line (SSFL). The SSFL is a 36 kilometre dedicated freight line between Macarthur and Sefton and the new track is within the existing rail corridor. The SSFL will allow passenger and freight services to operate independently, freeing up passenger lines for improved services and providing more capacity for freight trains on the dedicated lines.
