



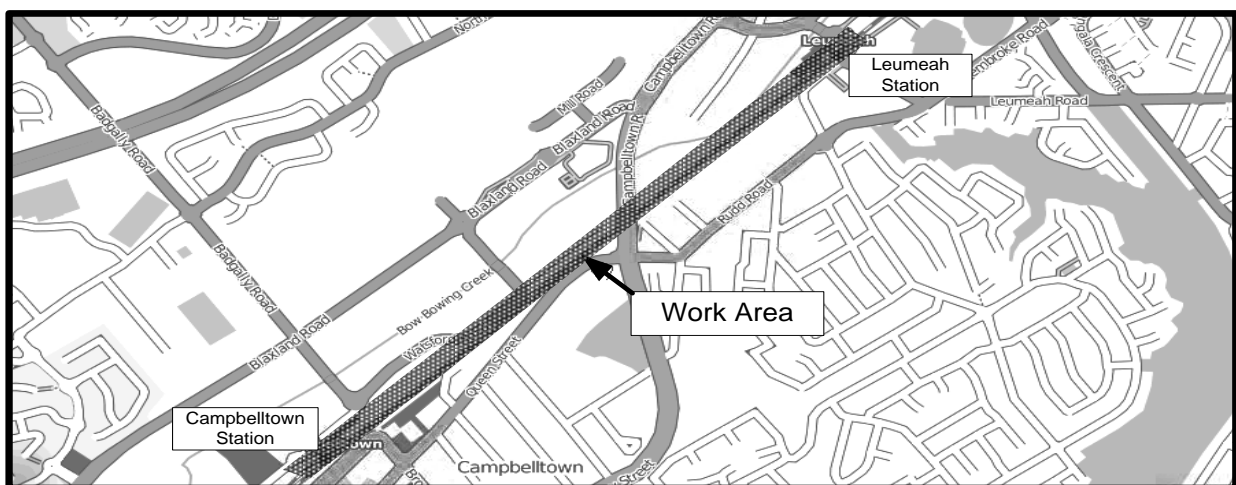

## Southern Sydney Freight Line IMPORTANT COMMUNITY INFORMATION Leumeah to Campbelltown – Weekend Works

Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) will be undertaking construction work in your area. These works must be undertaken outside normal construction hours because of the safety risks involved with working in close proximity to overhead power and rail track.

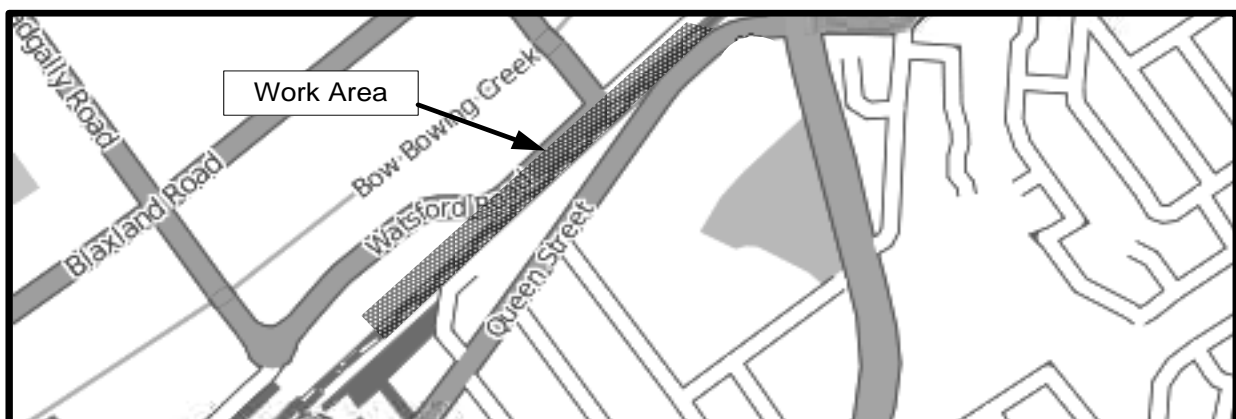
### Leumeah Station to Campbelltown Station

These works will take place on Saturday 22 and Sunday 23 January 2011 from 7am to 6pm, with a contingency period from 6pm to 10pm on both days. These works will include installing, changing over and commissioning of signalling and communications cables (Combined Services Route Zone 2). The equipment required for these works include site vehicles, power winches, generators and non-powered hand tools.



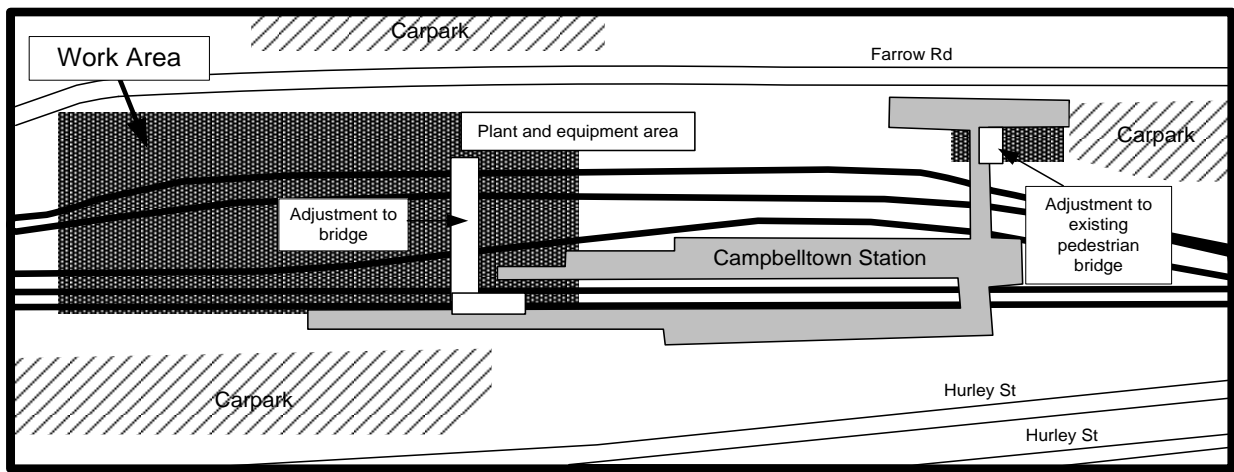
### Queen Street, Campbelltown

These works will take place on Saturday 22 and Sunday 23 January 2011 from 7am to 6pm, with a contingency period from 6pm to 10pm on both days. The works will include relocating a signalling cabinet. The equipment required for these works include site vehicles, hammer drill, hi-rail Hiab truck and non-powered hand tools.



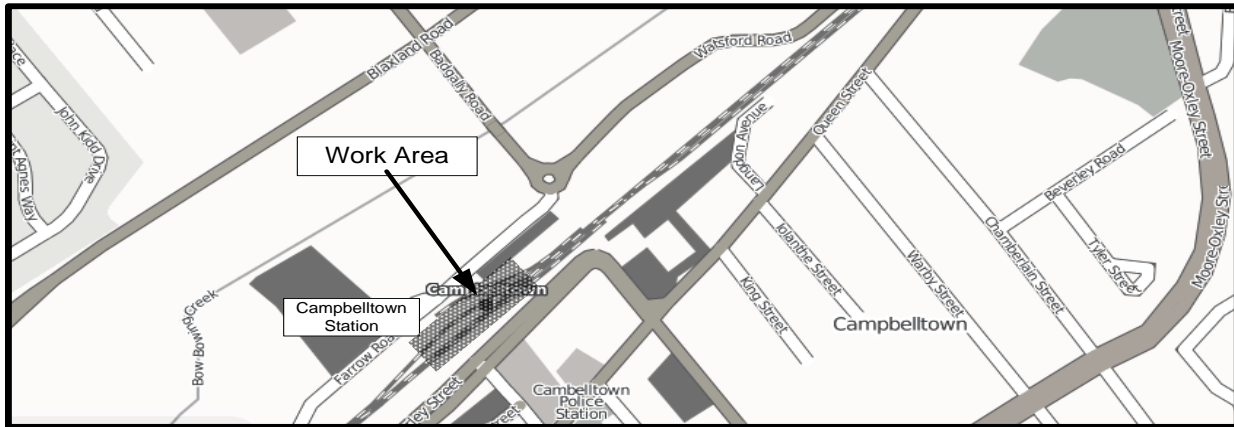
### Campbelltown Station

These works will take place from 7am to 6pm on Saturday 22 and from 8am to 6pm on Sunday 23 January 2011, with a contingency period from 6pm to 10pm on both days. The works will include installing hand rails to the footbridge, making adjustments to the staff footbridge and lighting, piling, excavating, and altering previously installed hoarding. The equipment required will include a delivery truck, oxy sets, generator, 20t Franna, piling rig, excavator, concrete pump, concrete delivery vehicles, pressure washers, day maker lights, tip trucks, and powered and non-powered hand tools.



**Campbelltown Station and Yard**

These works will take place on Saturday 22 and Sunday 23 January 2011 from 7am to 6pm, with a contingency period from 6pm to 10pm on both days. The works will include installing smoke screens on Campbelltown Footbridge. The equipment required will include two Manitou cranes, two cherry pickers, two generators, and powered and non-powered hand tools.
