Southern Sydney Freight Line IMPORTANT COMMUNITY INFORMATION

Campbelltown and Liverpool Community Liaison Group (CLG)

Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) is constructing the Southern Sydney Freight Line (SSFL) project. These works which will provide a dedicated 36 kilometre freight line between Macarthur and Sefton in southern Sydney.

The SSFL is approved under Part 3A of the NSW EP&A Act (1979). As part of the Project's conditions of approval, a CLG exists for each Local Government Area (LGA) affected by the Project. In Campbelltown and Liverpool LGAs this CLG is a combined group.

The Campbelltown/Liverpool CLG has been operating since July 2008 and meets monthly (currently the 3rd Wednesday of each month at Liverpool City Library). The group's numbers have varied over time and we are now calling for further members of the public to join this group. The CLG will operate for the duration of construction and for two meetings post construction. Whilst not a decision making body, the CLG has a consultative role and members are encouraged to represent the community's view and to disseminate information back to the community about the project. Membership of the CLG is not remunerated.
