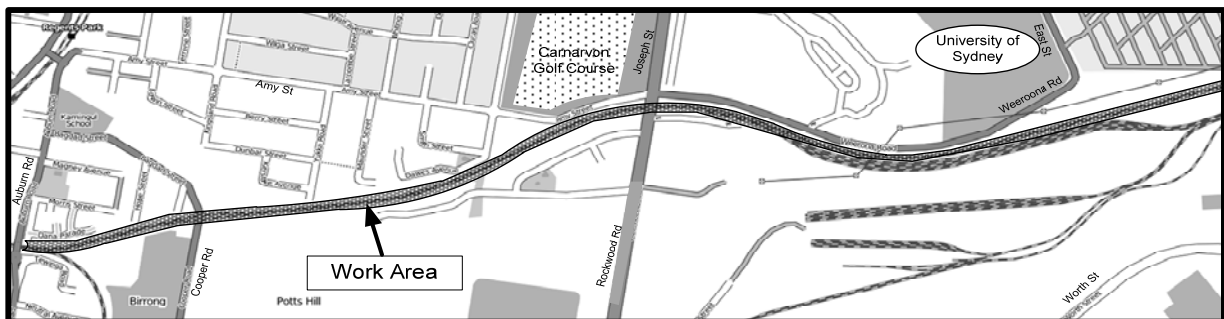
Construction Work at Birrong, Sefton and Regents Park

Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) will be undertaking various construction works at Birrong, Regents Park and Sefton. These works must be undertaken outside normal construction because there are safety risks involved with working in close proximity to the overhead wires and tracks.

Rookwood Cemetery to Auburn Road

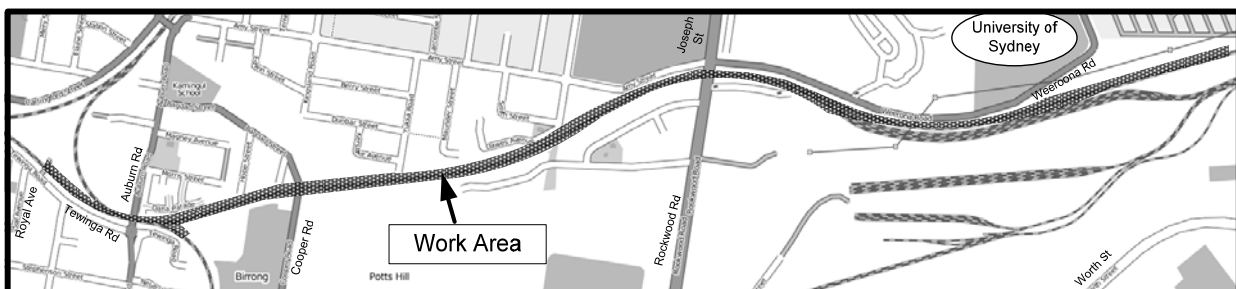
Removal of overhead wiring stanchions and footings, installation of signal posts and bases, modification of track circuits, installation of points machines (signalling) and testing and commissioning will be undertaken from 2am Saturday 2 April to 2am Monday 4 April 2011. The equipment used will include site vehicles, non-powered hand tools, hi rail crane truck, two hi rail telehandlers, two cherry pickers, 5t excavator and four daymaker floodlights.

Testing and commissioning of signals, signalling and communications cables will be continued on weeknights from 6pm to 7am Monday 4 to Friday 8 April and from 6pm Friday 8 to 2am Saturday 9 April. A contingency will be in place from 6pm to 7am Monday 11 April to Wednesday 13 April, and from 6pm Wednesday 13 April to 2am Thursday 14 April. The equipment used will include site vehicles, non-powered hand tools and four daymaker floodlights.



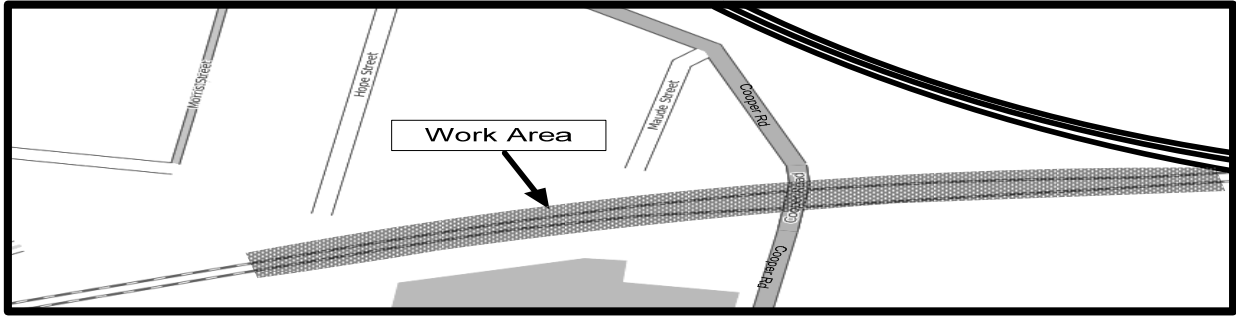
Rookwood Cemetery to Royal Avenue

Installation of cable route, cutting over new track circuits and location cases, installation of points machines (signalling), and testing and commissioning will be undertaken from 2am Saturday 9 April to 2am Monday 11 April 2011. The equipment used will be site vehicles, non-powered hand tools, crane truck, 4t dumper truck, 5t excavator and four daymaker floodlights.



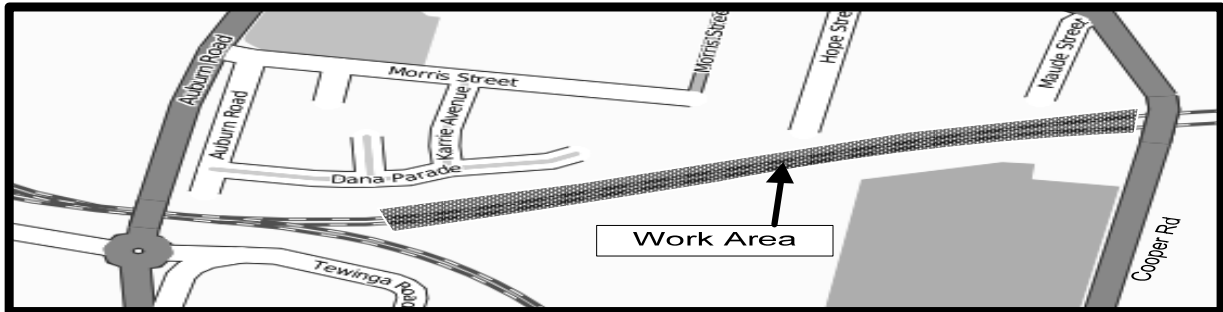
Cooper Road

Earthworks will be undertaken from 6am to 7pm on Saturday 9 April and Sunday 10 April 2011. The equipment used will be two 25t excavators, front end loader, 17t static roller, four dump trucks, bogies, back hoes, water cart, bobcat, and powered and non-powered hand tools.



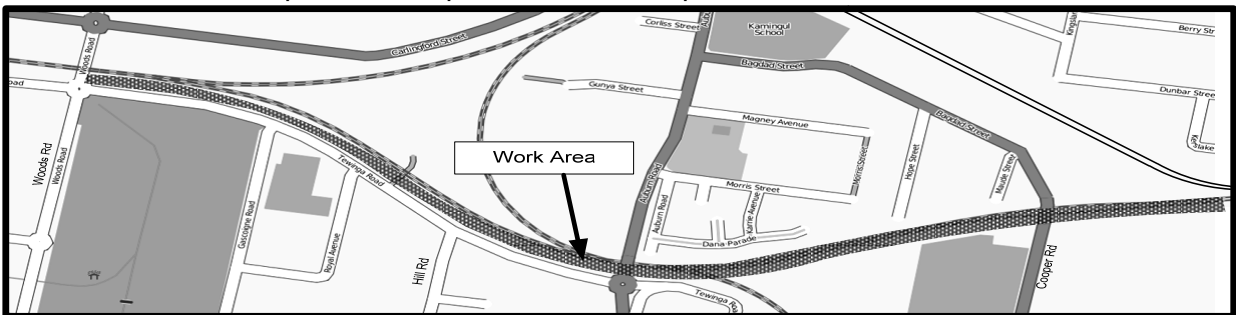
Cooper Road to Tewinga Road

Track removal and alteration and signalling testing and commissioning, will be undertaken from 2am Saturday 2 April to 7am Monday 4 April 2011. The equipment used will be two 14t-16t excavators, two front end loaders, three 5t-14t dump trucks, tamper and regulator, six daymaker floodlights, small track machines, hand tools, water cart and oxy sets. In addition a rail grinder, 10t vibrating roller and rail saw will be used during daylight hours only.



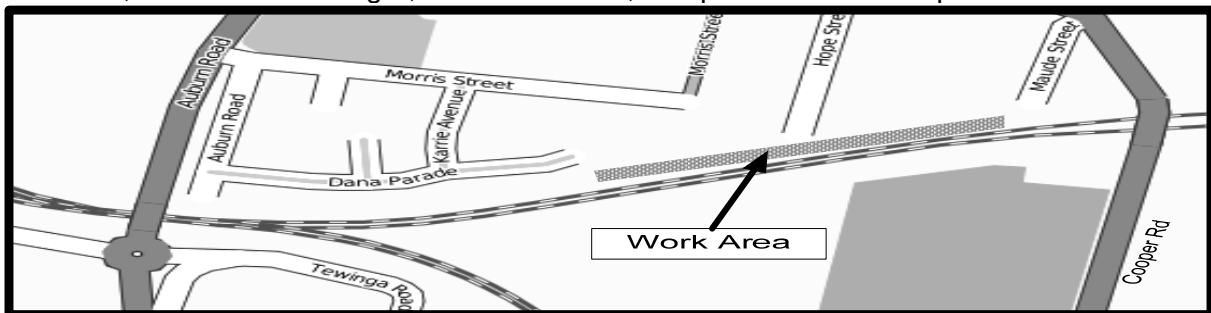
East of Cooper Road to Woods Road

Removal of danger zone fencing adjacent to track will be undertaken from 7am to 6pm Saturday 9 April and from 8am to 6pm Sunday 10 April 2011. The equipment used will be a hiab truck, 12t excavator, table top truck, and powered and non-powered hand tools.



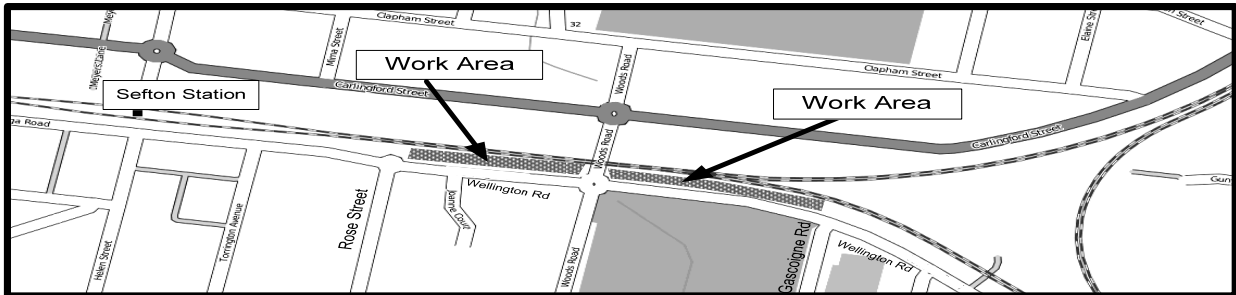
Maude Street to Dana Parade

Removal of a power pole and the installation of two new poles will be undertaken from 7am to 6pm Saturday 26 March and 2 April and from 8am to 6pm Sunday 27 March and 10 April 2011. The equipment used will include two elevated work platforms, pole truck with hydraulic lift, pot hole truck, truck mounted auger, truck and trailer, and powered and non-powered hand tools.



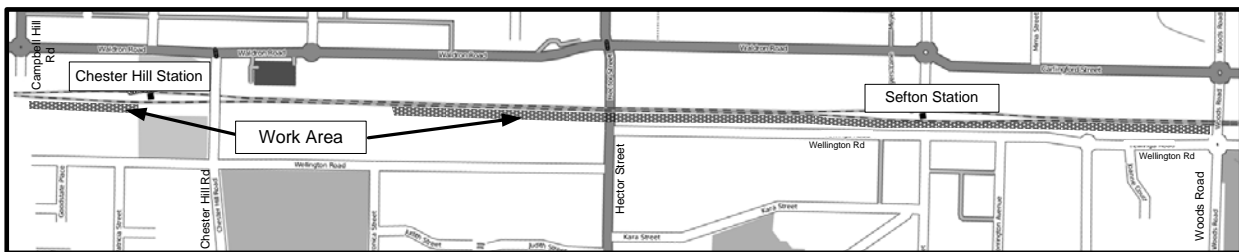
Gascoigne Road to Rose Street

Excavation, laying and backfilling of inter-track stormwater drainage will be undertaken from 6am Saturday 9 April to 10pm Sunday 10 April 2011. The equipment used will include a 12t excavator, tip truck, bogie tipper, wacker packer, concrete trucks and pumps (to be used intermittently), and powered and non-powered hand tools.



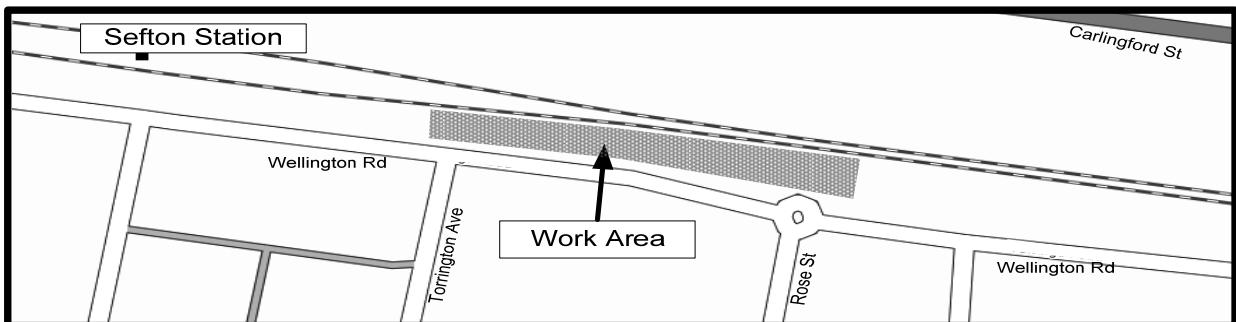
Woods Road, Sefton to west of Chester Hill Station

Installation of noise barriers will be undertaken from 7am to 6pm Saturday 9 April and from 8am to 6pm Sunday 10 April 2011. The equipment used will be a 20t franna crane, elevated work platform, hiab truck, 5t excavator, and powered and non-powered hand tools.



Wellington Road between Rose Street and Torrington Avenue

Removal of sheet piles will be undertaken from 7am to 6pm Saturday 9 April and from 8am to 6pm Sunday 10 April 2011. The equipment used will be a 25t excavator, bogies, and powered and non-powered hand tools.
