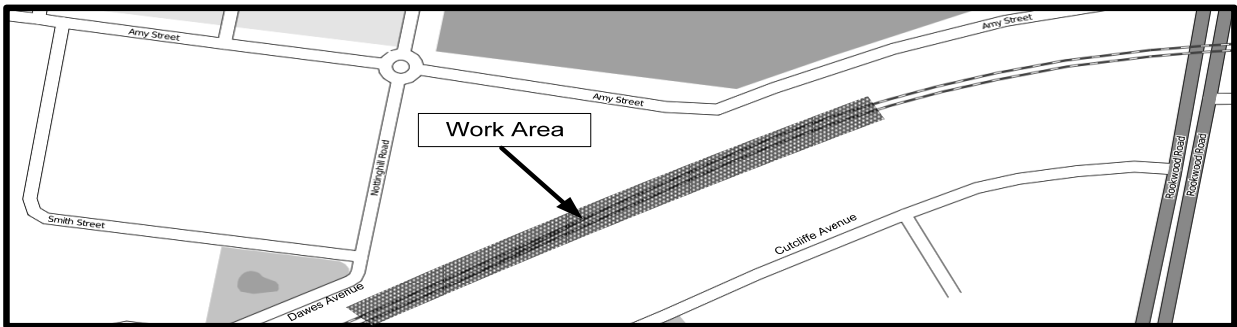
## Southern Sydney Freight Line IMPORTANT COMMUNITY INFORMATION

### Construction Work at Regents Park, Sefton and Chester Hill

Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) will be undertaking construction work from Regents Park to Chester Hill. This work must be undertaken outside normal construction because there are safety risks involved with working in close proximity to the overhead wires and tracks.

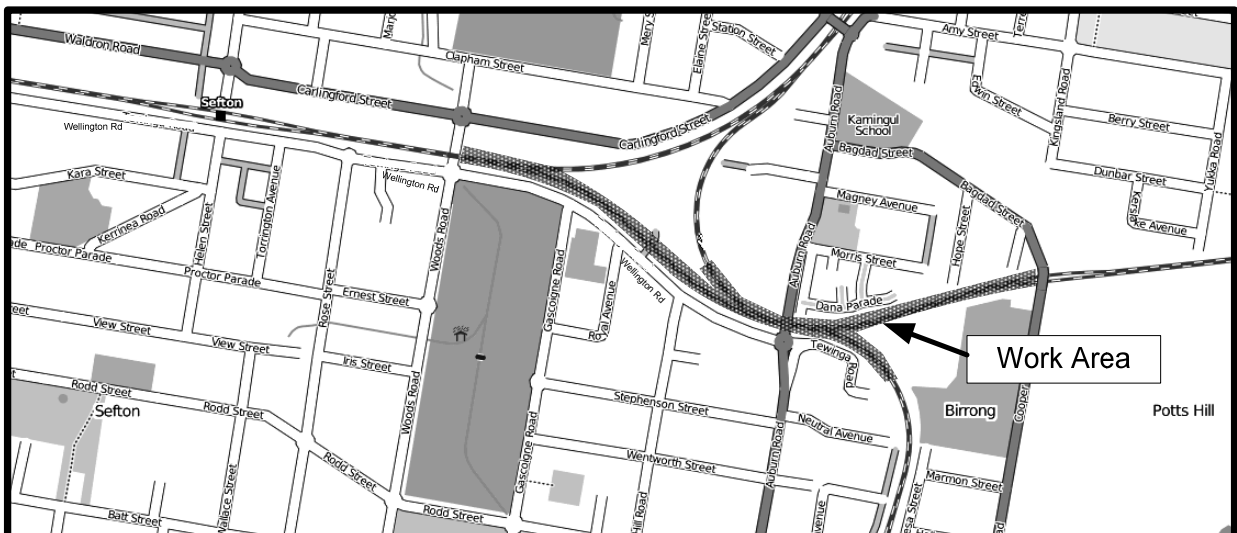
#### Amy Street to Dawes Avenue, Regents Park

Track maintenance, involving retrofitting turnout rollers, will be undertaken from 7am to 6pm Saturday 28 May and from 8am to 6pm Sunday 29 May 2011. The equipment used will include a 4t dump truck and powered and non-powered hand tools.



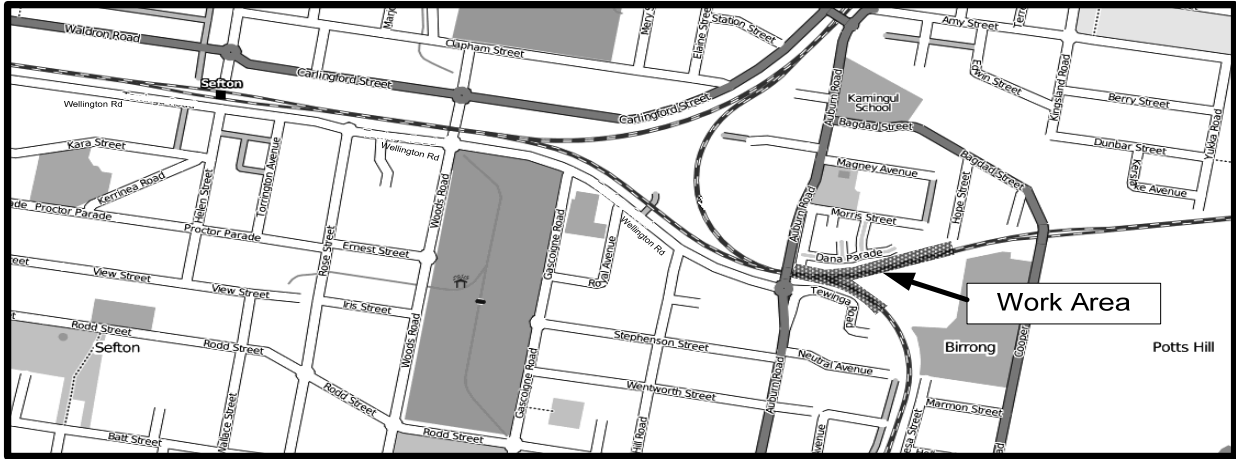
#### Cooper Road to Woods Road, Sefton

Installing, re-profiling and commissioning of overhead wires will be undertaken from 7am to 7pm Saturday 28 May and between 12pm Sunday 29 May and 12am Monday 30 May 2011. The equipment used will include a hi-rail crane truck, two hi-rail cherry pickers, a hi-rail scissor lift, two cranes, lighting towers, site vehicles, and powered and non-powered hand tools.



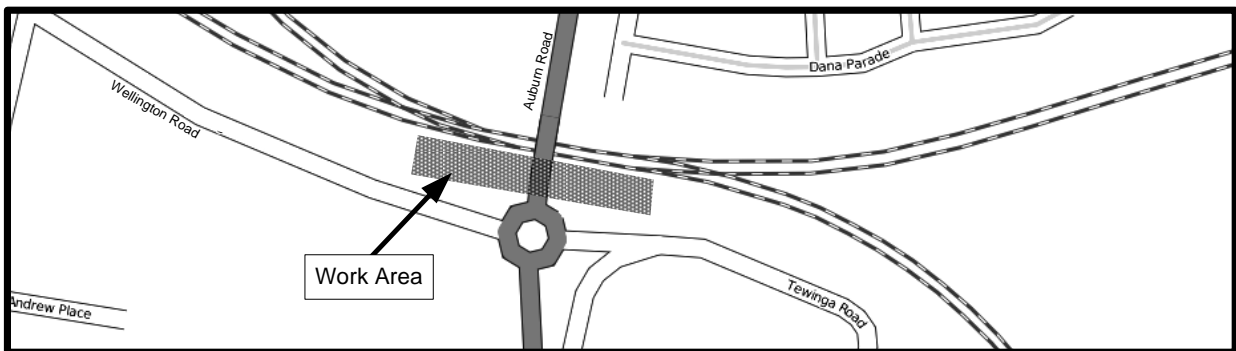
### Hope Street to Auburn Road, Regents Park

Track maintenance, including resurfacing the track and installing concrete guard rails and glued insulated joints, will be undertaken from 2am Saturday 28 May to 12am Monday 30 May 2011. The equipment used will include three front end loaders, four 14t dump trucks, two 15t excavators, two drots, tamper, regulator, vibrating roller, four lighting towers, and powered and non-powered hand tools.



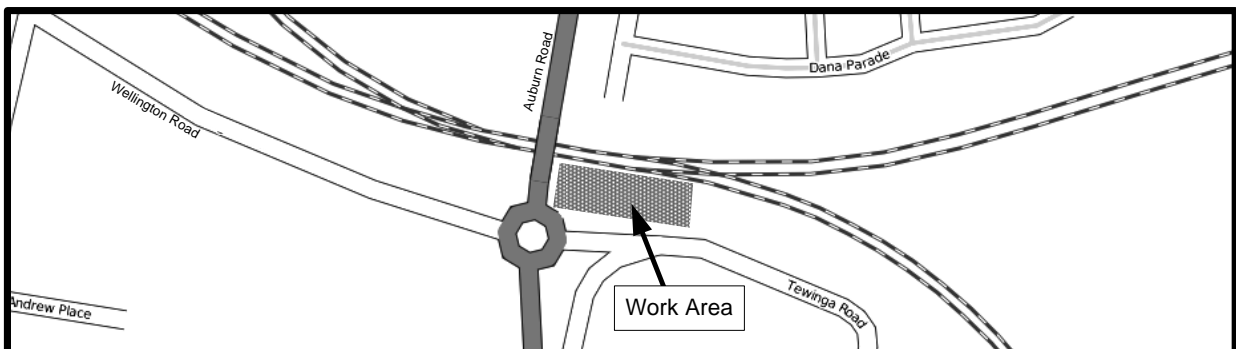
### Auburn Road, Birrington

Relocating a gas main along Auburn Road, including excavating, modifying and relocating the main, will be undertaken from 7am to 6pm Saturday 28 May and from 8am to 6pm Sunday 29 May 2011. The equipment used will include a 5t mobile excavator, bogie tippers, dump truck, two elevated work platforms, telehandler, oxy sets, and powered and non-powered hand tools.



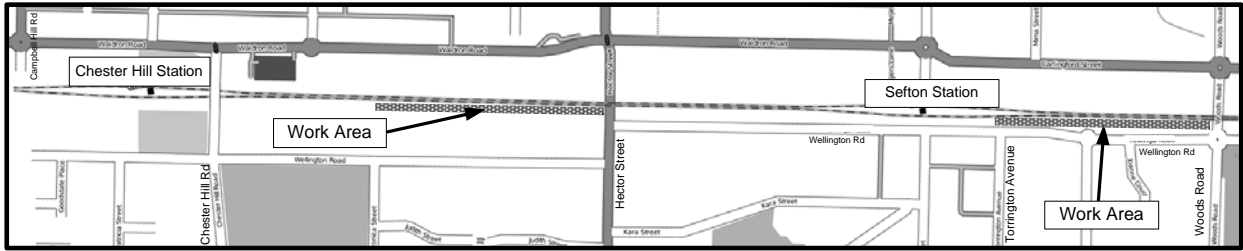
### Tewinga Road, Sefton

Pump station construction in the track excavation underneath the Bankstown line, including lifting materials into the excavation, fitting pump sections and connecting services, will be undertaken from 7am to 6pm Saturday 28 May and from 8am to 6pm Sunday 29 May 2011. The equipment used will include two 50t cranes, two elevated work platforms, a hiab truck, and powered and non-powered hand tools.



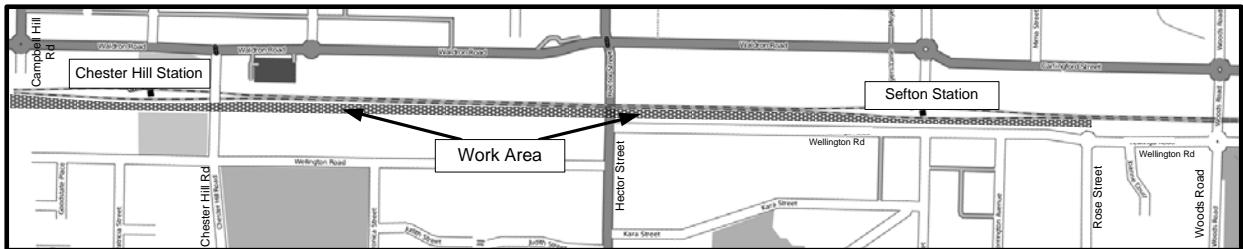
### Woods Road, Sefton to west of Chester Hill Station

Installation of noise barriers will be undertaken from 7am to 6pm Saturday 28 May and from 8am to 6pm Sunday 29 May 2011. The equipment used will include a 20t franna crane, elevated work platform, hiab truck, 5t excavator, and powered and non-powered hand tools.



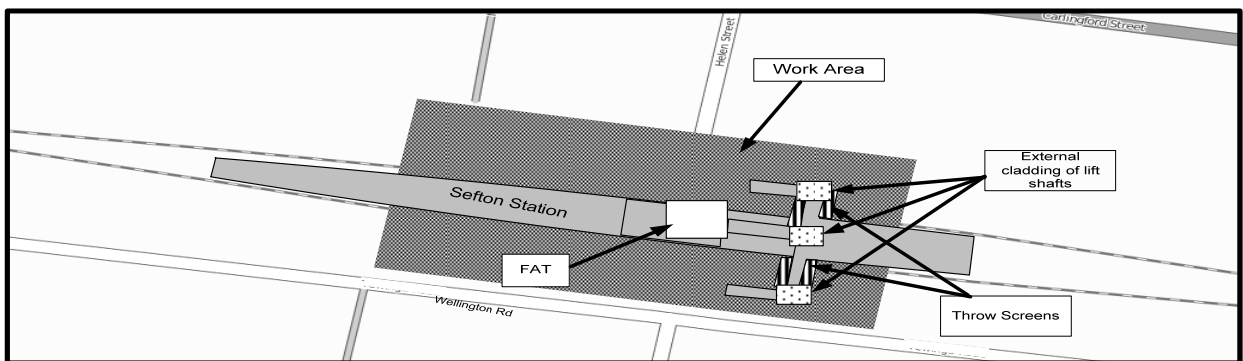
### Rose Street, Sefton to west of Chester Hill Station

Power pole removal and aerial works to connect power to an underground route will be undertaken from 7am to 6pm Saturday 28 May and from 8am to 6pm Sunday 29 May 2011. The equipment used will include two elevated work platforms, a pole truck with hydraulic lift, pothole truck, bogie tip trucks, diesel generator, oxy cutting set, grinder and both powered and non-powered hand tools.



### Sefton Station

Work in this area will include glazing and cladding the lift shafts, works to the family accessible toilet, strengthening the bridge, working on the throw screens, and a power upgrade. The work will be undertaken from 7am to 6pm Saturday 28 May and from 8am to 6pm Sunday 29 May 2011, with a contingency between 6pm and 10pm on both days. The equipment used to complete these works include a delivery truck, oxy sets, a 60t crane, 20t franna, scaffolding, an elevated work platform, and both powered and non-powered hand tools.
