



Southern Sydney Freight Line IMPORTANT COMMUNITY INFORMATION

Temporary site compound at 7 Montore Road, Minto

Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) will be constructing a temporary site compound within the industrial site at 7 Montore Road Minto, as part of the Southern Sydney Freight Line (SSFL) project.

Establishment works for the temporary compound **will commence in the week of 21 November 2011** and will take up to six weeks to complete, weather permitting. Works will involve conducting a pre-condition property survey of the area, followed by construction of the compound, which will include removal of vegetation within the site and implementing erosion and sediment controls.

Spoil from excavation will be recycled in the form earth bunds to reduce noise and visual impacts to the surrounding local businesses and community. The current security fencing will remain in place. During the construction of the temporary compound there may be an increase in truck and other machinery movements along Airds Road and Montore Road.

The temporary site compound is proposed to be in place for approximately 18 months and will be utilised by office staff as well as site staff. The site will be rehabilitated to its original state upon completion of the works.

The compound will be operated in accordance with Office of Environment and Heritage requirements, between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturday. Office staff may access the compound outside of these hours to undertake administration tasks.

Community notifications will be distributed to local businesses and community if we are required to undertake construction activities 'out of hours'.

We appreciate your patience while we occupy this land to complete this important project for Sydney and NSW.
