

## Southern Sydney Freight Line IMPORTANT COMMUNITY INFORMATION

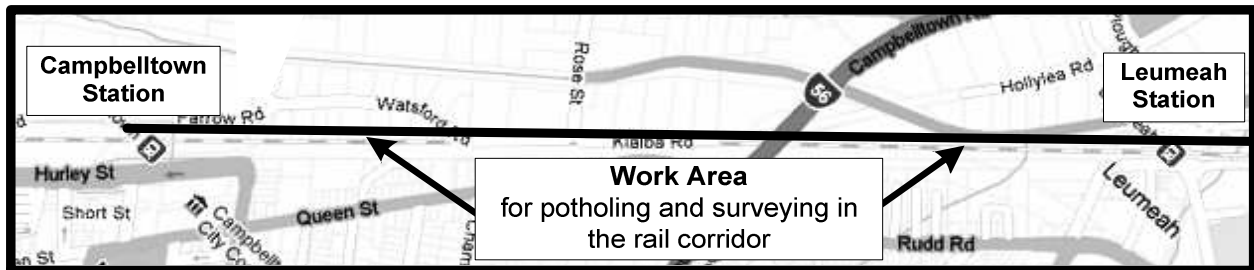
### Construction Works at Campbelltown

The Southern Sydney Freight Line (SSFL) will be undertaking construction work in your area. These works must be undertaken outside normal construction because there are safety risks involved with working in close proximity to the overhead wires and tracks. RailCorp has a track possession scheduled from 3 January to 22 January 2012, which means passenger trains won't be running on this weekend to allow construction work on the train lines. The Southern Sydney Freight line will utilise this track possession to undertake work safely.

#### Chester Road, Ingleburn to Campbelltown Station

Potholing and surveying works will take place from 7am to 6pm Saturday and 8am to 6pm Sunday on the weekends of 7-8, 14-15, and 21-22 January 2012. An approved contingency is in place from 6pm to 10pm on Sunday evening on 8, 15 and 22 January 2012.

The equipment used will include pothole trucks, lighting towers, portable generators, a bobcat and site vehicles.

#### Sackville Street, Ingleburn to Rose Street, Campbelltown

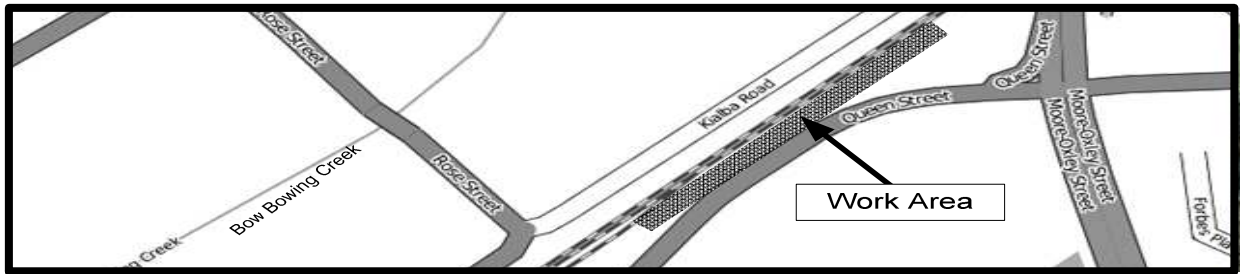
Excavation and installation of temporary sheet piles will take place from 7am to 6pm on Saturday and from 8am to 6pm on Sunday on the weekends of 7-8, 14-15, and 21-22 January 2012. The equipment used will include a 5t hi-rail excavator, 8t hi-rail tipper, hi-rail pothole truck, sheet piling rig, truck and dogs, site vehicles, and powered and non-powered hand tools.

#### Queen Street, Campbelltown

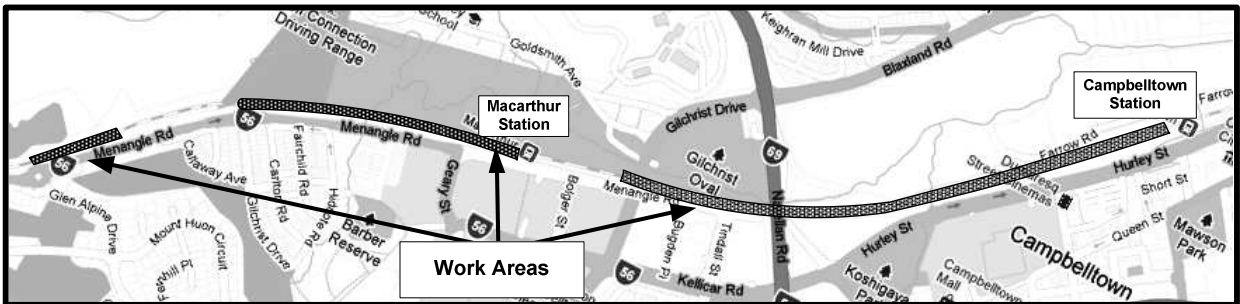
Cess drain works will take place from 7am to 6pm on Saturday and from 8am to 6pm on Sunday on the weekends of 7-8, 14-15, and 21-22 January 2012. An approved contingency is in place from 6pm to 10pm on Sunday evening on 8, 15 and 22 January 2012. The equipment used will include light vehicles, excavators, bogie trucks, and powered and non-powered hand tools.



**Broughton Street, Campbelltown to Menangle Road, Macarthur**

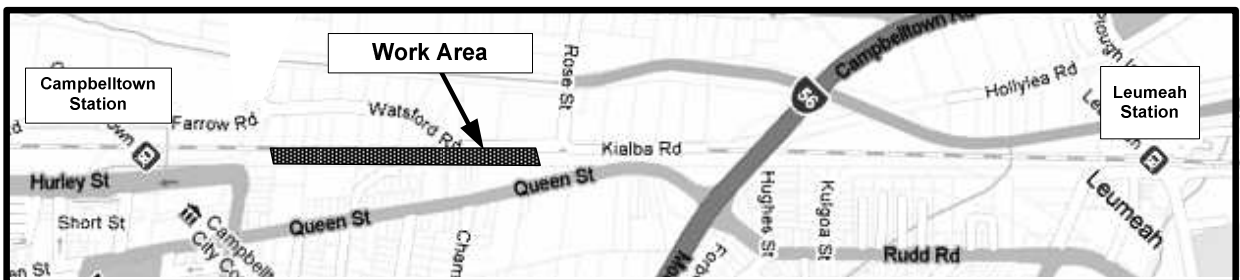
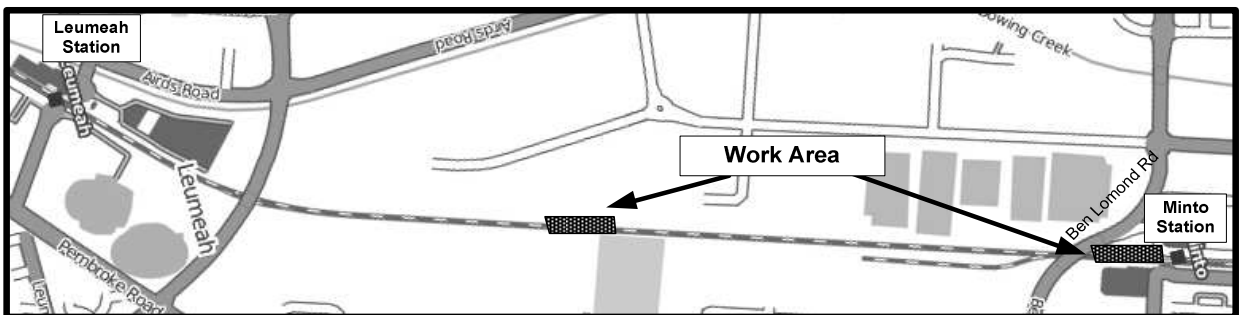
Potholing, drainage works and temporary works, including the installation of temporary piles and panels, from 7am to 6pm Saturday and 8am to 6pm Sunday on the weekends of 7-8, and 14-15. These works will also occur from 7am Saturday to 6pm Sunday on the weekend of 21-22 January 2012. An approved contingency is in place from 6pm to 10pm on Sunday evening on 8, 15 and 22 January 2012.

The equipment used will include light vehicles, excavators, bogie trucks and powered and non-powered hand tools.



**Freeman Circuit, Ingleburn to Victoria Road, Minto, and Ben Lomond Road, Minto South to Broughton Street, Campbelltown**

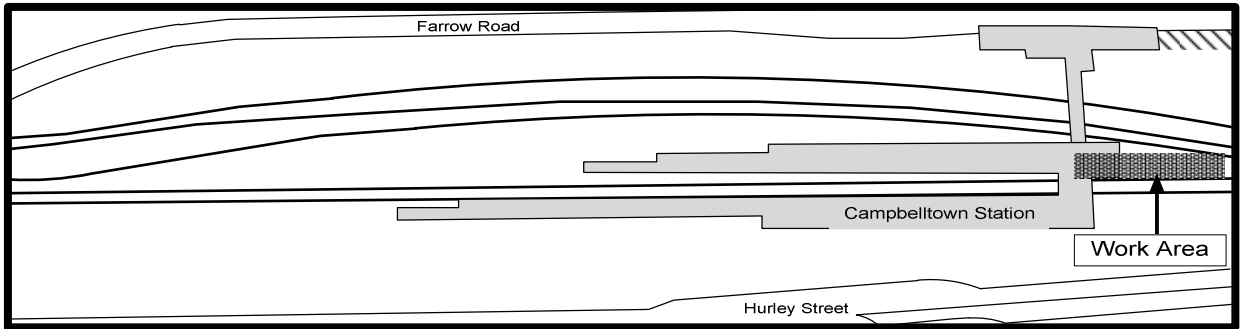
Removal of redundant signalling and communication pits will take place from 7am to 6pm Saturday and 8am to 6pm Sunday on the weekends of 7-8, 14-15, and 21-22 January 2012. An approved contingency is in place from 6pm to 10pm on Sunday evenings on 8, 15 and 22 January 2012. The equipment used will include light vehicles, 5t-20t excavators, bogie trucks, and powered and non-powered hand tools.

### Campbelltown Station

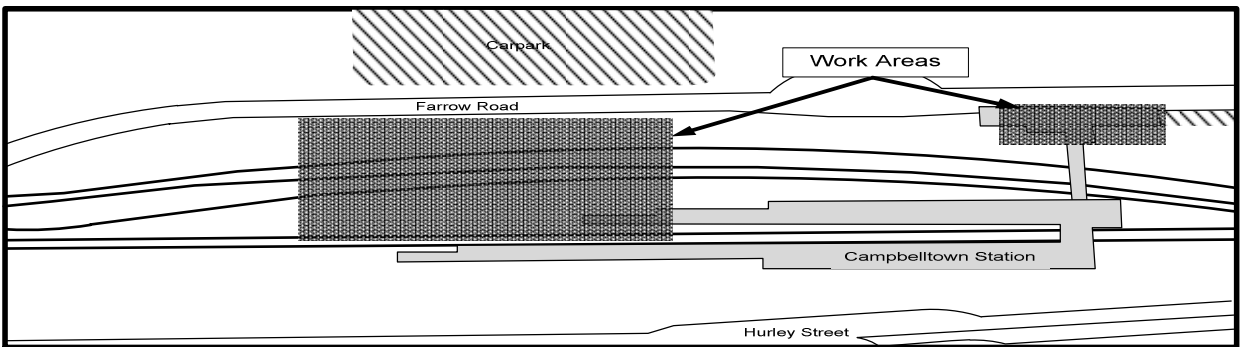
Construction of a cable route, hauling of cabling and installation of a concrete slab have been scheduled to take place from 7am to 10pm on Saturday 17 December and from 8am to 10pm on Sunday 18 December 2011. If this is not completed two approved contingency weekends are in place from 7am Saturday to 6pm on Sunday on either 7-8, 14-15, or 21-22 January 2012. The equipment used will include a concrete truck, tip truck, excavator, and powered and non-powered hand tools.



### Campbelltown Station

Staff footbridge works and works under the existing pedestrian bridge, including piling, deflection wall works and installation of structural steel components, will take place from 7am to 6pm on Saturday and from 8am to 6pm on Sunday on the weekends of 7-8, 14-15 and 21-22 January 2012. An approved contingency is in place from 6pm to 10pm on all days worked.

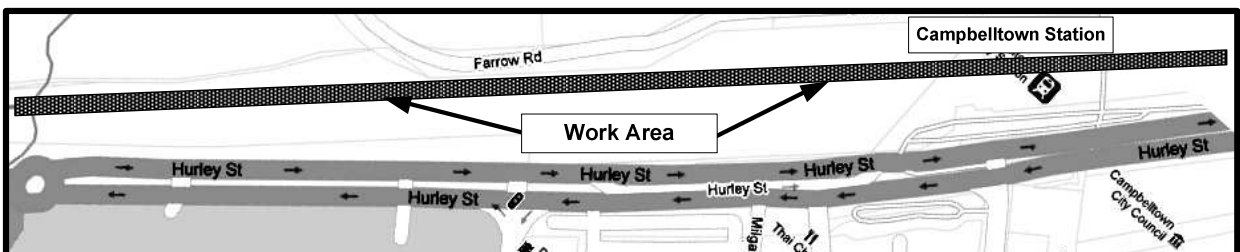
The equipment used will include a 100t crane, 20t franna, scaffolding, mobile elevated work platforms, concrete pump, oxy set, power saw, electric drill, generator, concrete saw, piling rig, high rail, knuckle boom, concrete vehicles, delivery vehicles, and powered and non-powered hand tools.



### Hurley Street, Campbelltown

Construction of concrete walkways and light pole installation, will take place from 5am Saturday to 11pm Sunday on the weekends of 7-8, 14-15, and 21-22 January 2012.

The equipment used will include light vehicles, concrete agitators and vibrators, a concrete saw, 13t excavator (contingency only), and powered and non-powered hand tools.
