### Community Notification – Trucks using Casula Road, Casula

---

ARTC is in an Alliance with Leighton Contractors and is delivering the Southern Freight Link (SFL). This work involves the construction of 36 kilometres of bi-directional, non electrified, dedicated freight line from Leightonfield to Glen Lee in south western Sydney.

Works in your surrounding area relating to the new freight line are well underway, including the construction of the 'Glenfield Flyover' and the Northern Approach Viaduct, south of Casula Powerhouse. To date, all SFL truck vehicles have accessed the site using an approved route through Shepherd Street in Liverpool, and Glenfield Road in Casula.

In times of wet weather, access through Shepherd Street is proving to be unsafe and not feasible due to the ground conditions during and after the rain. To allow us to continue the works, the alternate approved route along Casula Road will be utilised by trucks to gain entry to the site. This alternate route will be used **up until approximately December 2012** and only during times of inclement weather. It is expected that approximately 20 trucks per day may enter and leave the site depending on construction demands. This access will mainly be utilised during this time of wet weather, and predominantly for concrete trucks.

Due to the narrowness and winding nature of Casula Road truck drivers will be regularly briefed; to take all care when driving, to adhere to the conditions of the road and to be sensitive to the local community. Minor delays to allow trucks to pass may intermittently be experienced, and we apologise in advance for any inconvenience.

Southern Freight Link will do all that it can to minimise any inconvenience to you during this time; we ask that you take every care on Casula Road when sharing the road with these trucks, particularly in the wet.

We appreciate your patience and co-operation while we carry out the works to complete this important project for Sydney and NSW.
