

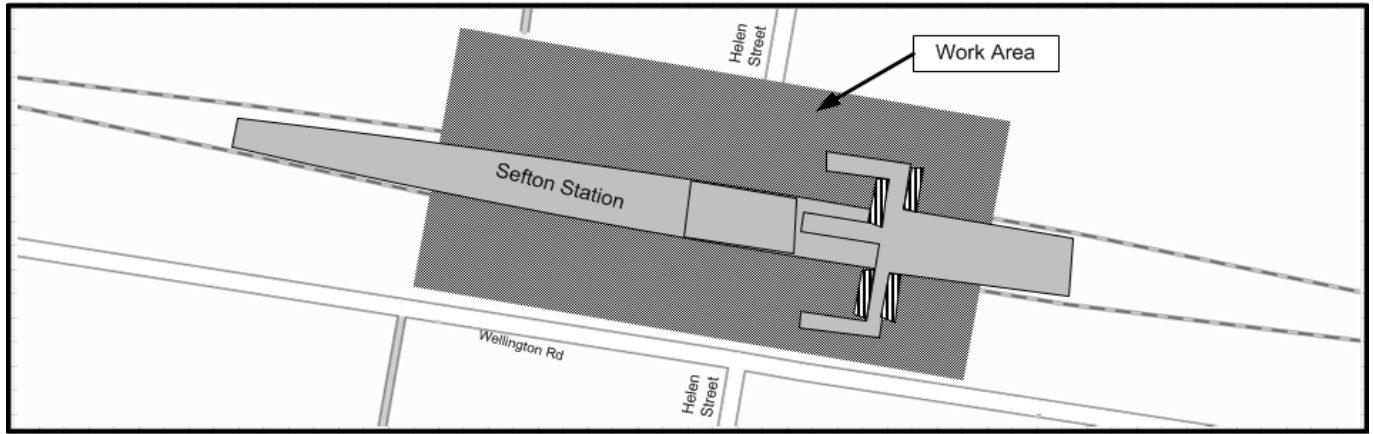
## The Southern Freight Link

### Community Notification – Construction work, Bankstown

The Southern Sydney Freight Line Project (SSFL) will be undertaking construction work in your area. These works must be undertaken outside normal construction because there are safety risks involved with working in close proximity to the overhead wires and tracks. RailCorp has a track possession scheduled from **18 to 19 February 2012**, which means passenger trains won't be running on this weekend to allow construction work on the train lines. The Southern Sydney Freight line will utilise this track possession to undertake work safely.

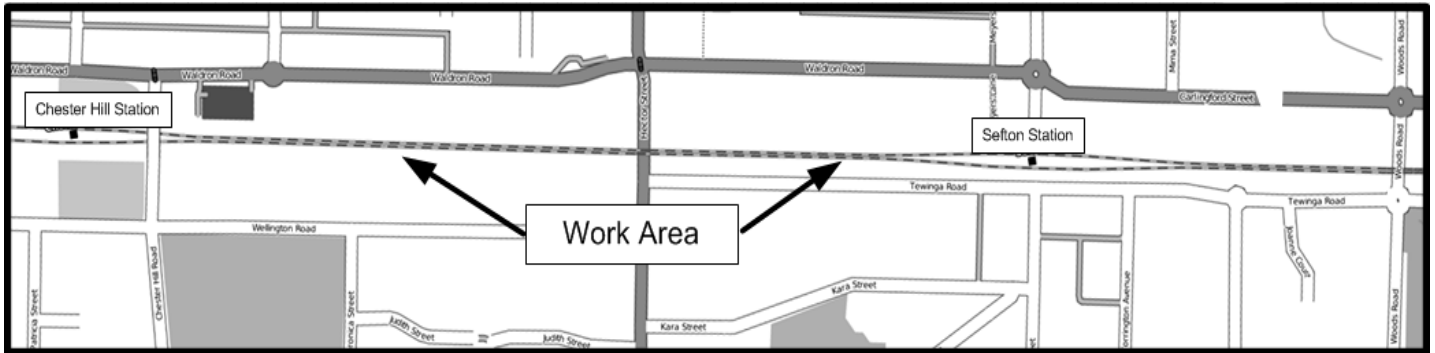
#### Sefton Station

Upgrading power works will be undertaken from **7am to 6pm Saturday 18**, and from **8am to 6pm Sunday 19 February 2012**. A contingency is in place from **6pm to 10pm on Saturday 18 and Sunday 19 February 2012** if required. The equipment to be used for these works will include a generator, and powered and non-powered hand tools.



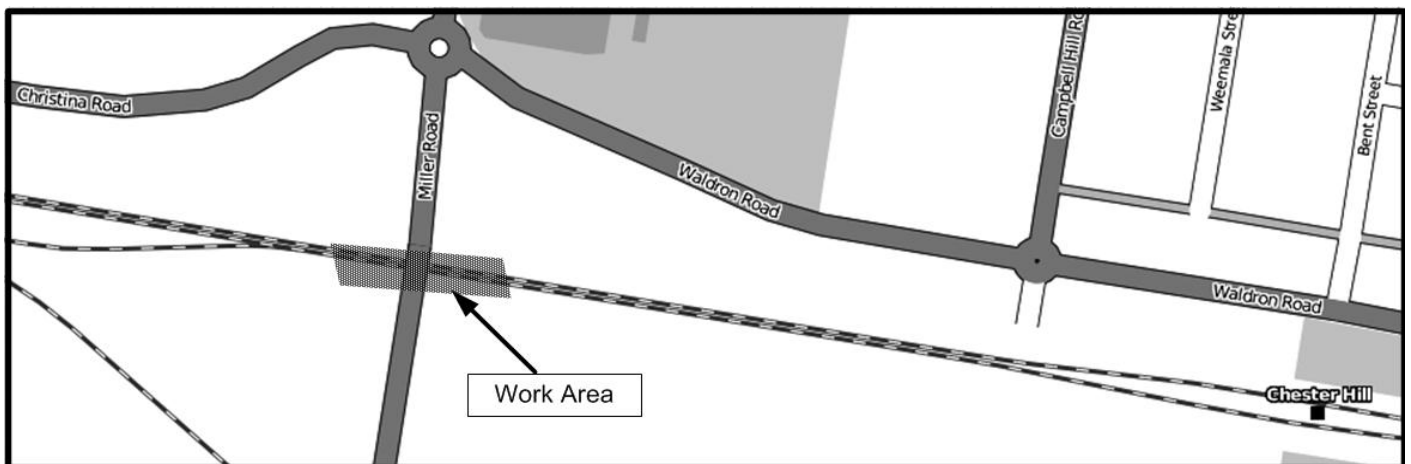
#### Sefton Station to Chester Hill Station

Cutting down existing redundant power poles and removing them from site by a large truck will be undertaken from **7am to 6pm Saturday 18**, and from **8am to 6pm Sunday 19 February 2012**. The equipment to be used for these works will include a 20t Franna crane, 50t crane truck, hi-rail Manitou crane, pole truck, 2t tip truck, and powered and non-powered hand tools.



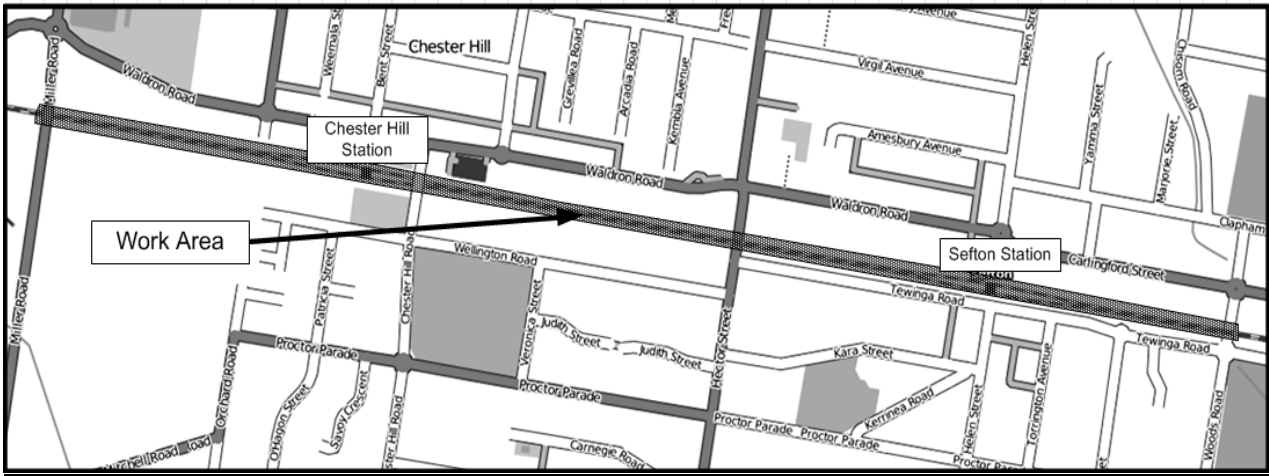
### Miller Road Bridge

Repair works to the Miller Road bridge wing walls will be undertaken from **7am to 6pm Saturday 18, and from 8am to 6pm Sunday 19 February 2012**. The equipment to be used for these works will include an elevated work platform, and powered and non-powered hand tools.



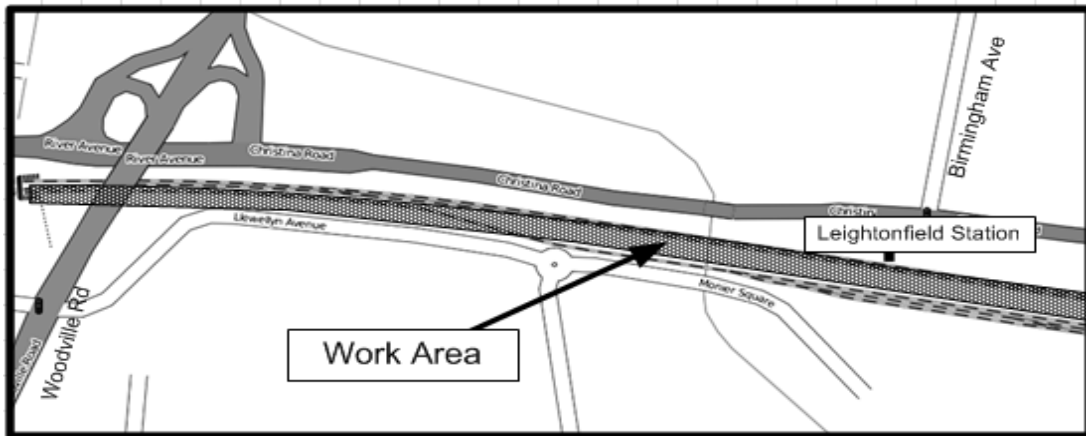
### Woods Road to Miller Road

Minor earthworks, and repairs to noise barriers and retaining walls will be undertaken from **7am to 6pm Saturday 18, and from 8am to 6pm Sunday 19 February 2012**. The equipment to be used for these works will include a 7t excavator, 12t bogie, 2t tip truck, elevated work platform, generator, lighting towers, and powered and non-powered hand tools.



**Leightonfield to Blue Circle Cement (Kamira Ave)-Villawood**

Installing aerial high voltage conductors will be undertaken from **5am to 6pm Saturday 18 February 2012**. A contingency is in place **from 5am to 6pm Sunday 19 February 2012** if required. The equipment to be used for these works will include a two elevated work platforms, and powered and non-powered hand tools. Traffic lanes will be closed on Woodville Road to allow stringing of aerial conductors across the roadway. Traffic controls will be in place to manage pedestrian and vehicular movements.
