Community Notification Construction work, Woodville Road, Villawood to Liverpool Hospital

The Southern Sydney Freight Line Project (SSFL) will be undertaking construction work in your area. These works must be undertaken outside normal construction because there are safety risks involved with working in close proximity to the overhead wires and tracks. RailCorp has a track possession scheduled from **18 to 19 February 2012**, which means passenger trains won't be running on this weekend to allow construction work on the train lines. The Southern Sydney Freight line will utilise this track possession to undertake work safely.

Woodville Road, Villawood to Liverpool Hospital

A large program of works has been scheduled to be undertaken along the rail corridor as depicted in the image, below. These works include the construction of the main cable route, cess drainage, inter-track drainage and excavation of structural fill, capping, potholing and tree removal works, will be undertaken from **7am Saturday 18 February to 10pm Sunday 19 February 2012**. The equipment to be used for these works will include 13t and 20t excavators, Franna Crane, Grader, truck with bogie, trench digger, and excavator with hammer attachment for breaking rock. Other equipment to be used includes hand tools, light vehicles generators and lighting towers.



The Horsley Drive to Prospect Creek, Carramar

Installing aerial high voltage conductors will be undertaken from **7am to 6pm, Saturday 18** and from **8am to 6pm Sunday 19, February 2012**. A contingency is in place to complete the works over one weekend between 25 February and 25 March 2012. The equipment to be used for these works will include a two elevated work platforms, and powered and non-powered hand tools.



Fourth Avenue Footbridge, Canley Vale

Erecting a temporary staircase for public use will be undertaken from **7am Saturday 18, to 10pm Sunday 19 February 2012**. The equipment to be used for these works will include light vehicles, flat bed trucks for deliveries, 5t excavators with compaction plates, chainsaws, woodchip machine, stump grinder, scaffolding, generators, lighting towers, and powered and non-powered hand tools.



Site Compounds located at Warwick Farm, Villawood and Fraser Road

Compounds located at Manning Street, Warwick Farm, Fraser Road, Canley Vale and the Villawood train station, will be used **between 7am Saturday 18 February to 10pm Sunday 19 February 2012**. The compounds will be in use to facilitate the works for deliveries, staff amenities, and deliveries of supplies.
