MACARTHUR TO SEFTON • ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT EXHIBITION

Environmental Assessment

The Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) is planning to improve rail freight services in NSW by building a new dedicated freight line from south of Macarthur Station to east of Sefton Station. The SSFL project also includes the modification of six suburban rail stations including Leumeah, Minto, Casula, Warwick Farm, Cabramatta and Sefton.

An Environmental Assessment (EA) has been produced that describes the proposal, its method of construction, the associated environmental impacts and management of those impacts. The EA process has involved consultation with the community and stakeholders.

What Happens Next

The EA is on public exhibition from 3 May 2006 to 2 June 2006. It is available for viewing at several locations and online (www.ssfl.artc.com.au).

Members of the community are invited to make comment on the EA.

Following exhibition of the EA the submissions received are considered in a Submissions Report. This report and the EA are assessed by the Department of Planning prior to approval being granted by the Minister for Planning. Approval is also required from the Commonwealth Minister for the Environment and Heritage.
